

Coronavirus/ COVID 19 Information

Dear Parent/Guardians,

At this time, the Center for Disease Control (CDC) has confirmed that there are COVID 19 virus cases in NJ. Information to date suggests that the virus causes mild to moderate illness and symptoms similar to the flu, including fever, cough, and difficulty breathing.

Public school districts are putting action plans together that will allow for temporary school closures if necessary. The health and safety of your children and our staff are of the utmost importance. Since we do occupy space in the school, we will follow any school closure policy that is in effect. Please be sure to have a child care contingency plan in place if the decision is made to close the school for a period of time.

What we are doing

It is recommended that individuals follow these public health guidelines, not just for COVID 19, but also to prevent the spread of influenza:

- We are consistently reminding the children to cover their coughs and sneezes.
- We remind the children to wash their hands for 20 seconds and have plenty of alcohol based sanitizer on hand.
- We always remind the children to avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth.
- We routinely clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- We follow the NJ state sickness policy and guidelines.

Please help us combat the spread of COVID19 by keeping your child home if they are sick or display any flu symptoms and try to incorporate the above guidelines at home.
