



Tuition Plan for Temporary Absences

March 16, 2020

Dear Parents / Guardians:

Effective as of 8:00 PM today, the State of NJ has enacted restrictions on the operation of non-essential businesses. Daycares have been excluded from the restrictions. Therefore, Wee Kids, as previously stated will continue to stay open as long as feasible.

We understand that you may choose to keep your child at home during this time so we have been putting classroom activities together that you can do with your children when at home.

Today, we had 40 children in attendance but as time goes on we do expect that number to go down. As long as the number of children that attend each day remains above 25, we will stay open for the duration of the public school shut down.

In an attempt to help our families as much as possible, while trying to maintain a running center for those in need, we have developed a new tuition rate sheet for families that decide to keep their children at home but want to ensure continued enrollment. The new tuition rate will be 15% of your normal tuition rate which will go toward the center's fixed expenses (i.e. rent, insurance, utilities, technology, office staff). If you were charged your normal rate today and plan to not have your child attend, your account will be refunded the tuition payment less the 15% charge.

Example – If your normal tuition is \$200.00/week, your rate if you decide to keep your child at home would be \$30.00/week.

Please know that we truly recognize the difficulties that this situation has brought to each of our families. It has been challenging, to say the least, to help the families that need care, the employees that need hours, and be fair to the families that are forced, or elect, to keep children at home.
