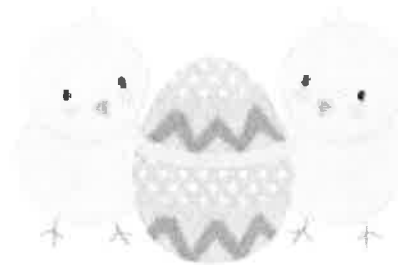
5 Little Chicks

on me!

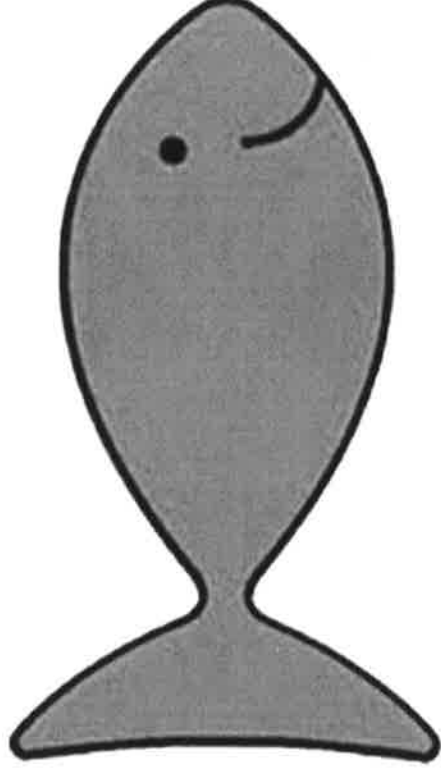


Oh Mister Sun, Sun,
