# rainbow numbers & shapes

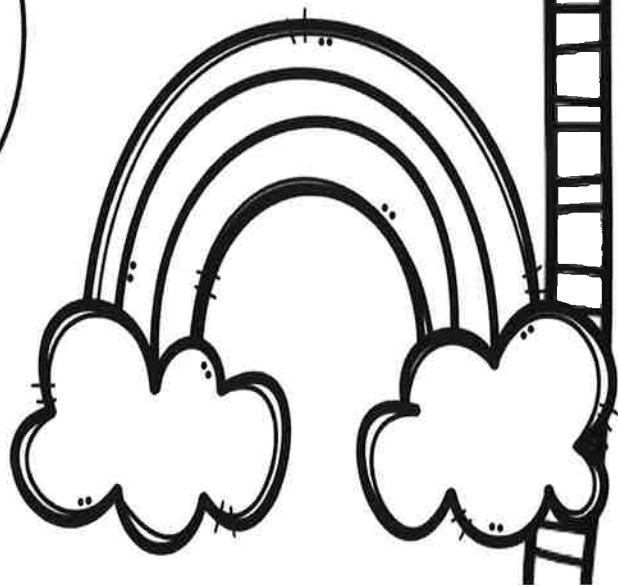

# Shamrock Sort

Print on cardstock and laminate for durability. Keep the sorting boards together as one piece or cut apart to use in a pocket chart. Cut apart the shamrock cards.

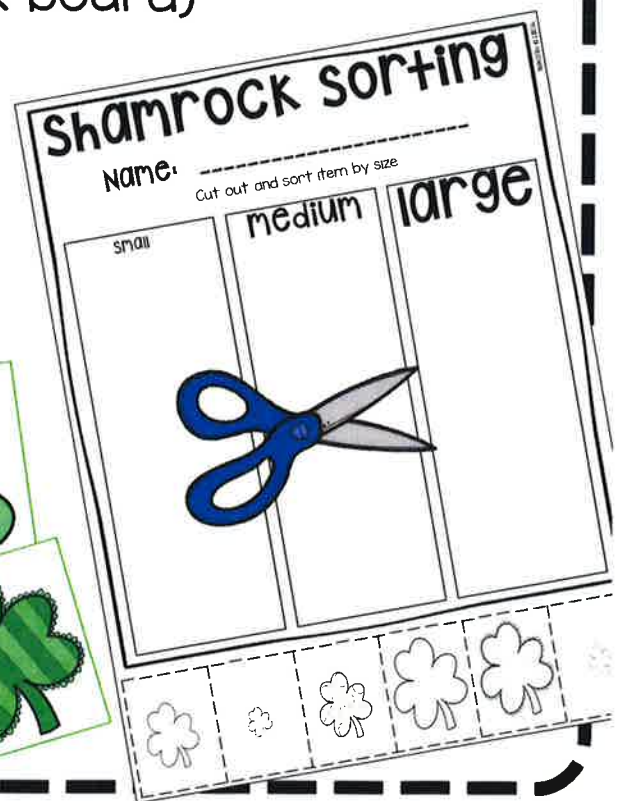
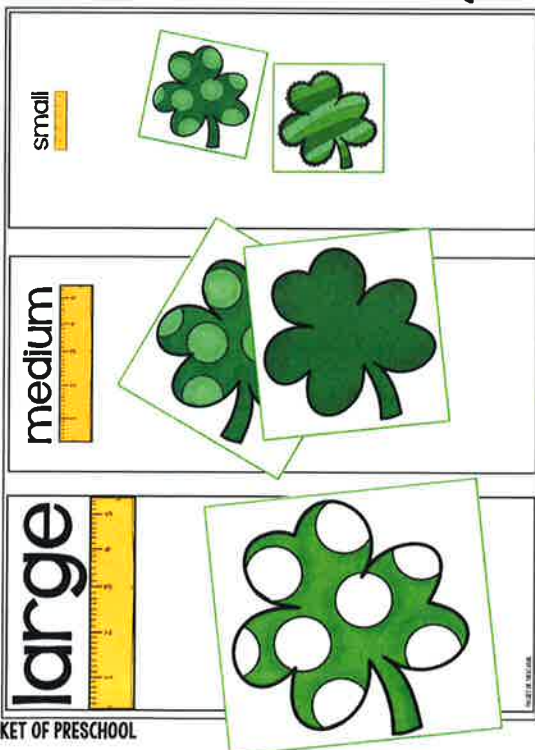
How to play:

Optional student recording page.

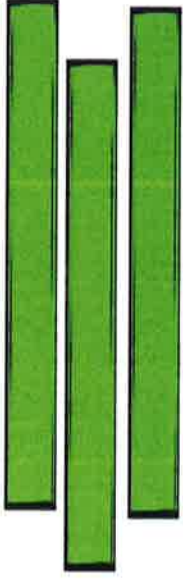
Sorting Boards:

- student choice (use the blank board)

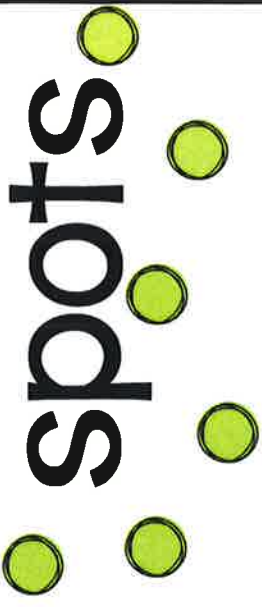

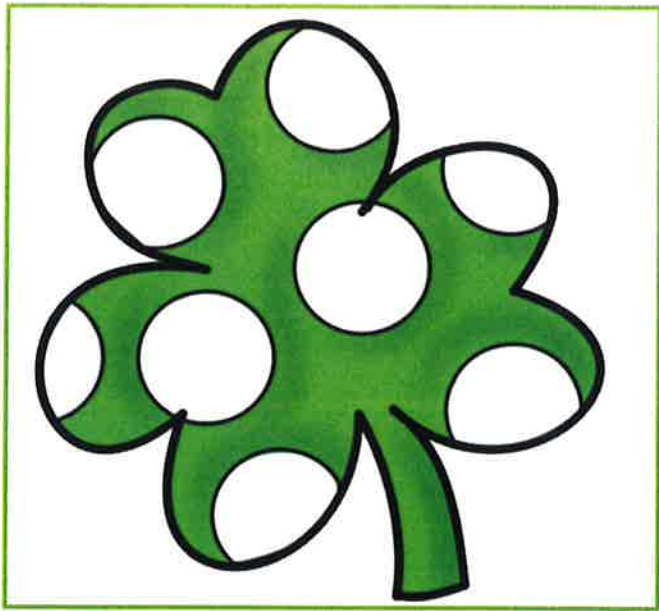

# Shamrock Collage

Print and copy a shamrock for each student.

Students cut out the shamrock then... you have options:

- Cut various shapes of green paper strips for the students ahead of time and students cut the paper strips into squares. Students glue the pieces on the shamrock.
- Use green tissue paper squares for the collage. Students can crumble the tissue into a ball and glue to the shamrock.
