Dear Parents/Guardians:

We hope you and your families are doing well and finding ways to cope while we all work through these usual times.

Wee Kids has applied, and been approved by the state, to become an “essential worker” center. This means that we will be able to remain open for parents/guardians that are “essential workers” and in need of childcare. Please click this [link](#) for the definition of an “essential worker”. There are new state childcare regulations that we must follow in order to remain open.

1. We will be conducting a screening of anyone coming into the center which will include:
  - Daily temperature and symptom check of staff and children upon entry
  - Confirmation that no medications were used to lower the child’s temperature
  - Confirmation that you or your child has not been in close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID19 in the past 14 days
  - Confirmation that nobody in the household has symptoms of respiratory illness
2. We ask that parents stay in the front foyer while we bring your child out to you.
3. We ask that our parents use the hand sanitizer when entering our facility.
4. We will check your child in/out each day so no need to use the touch screen.
5. We have been, and will continue to sanitize all touch surfaces in the school and entry way
6. We will be concentrating on keeping the children separated as much as possible
7. We will be giving the children extra time on the outdoor playground and outdoor classroom
