## Paper Plate Sunflower

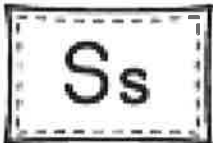
Paint or color a paper plate yellow.

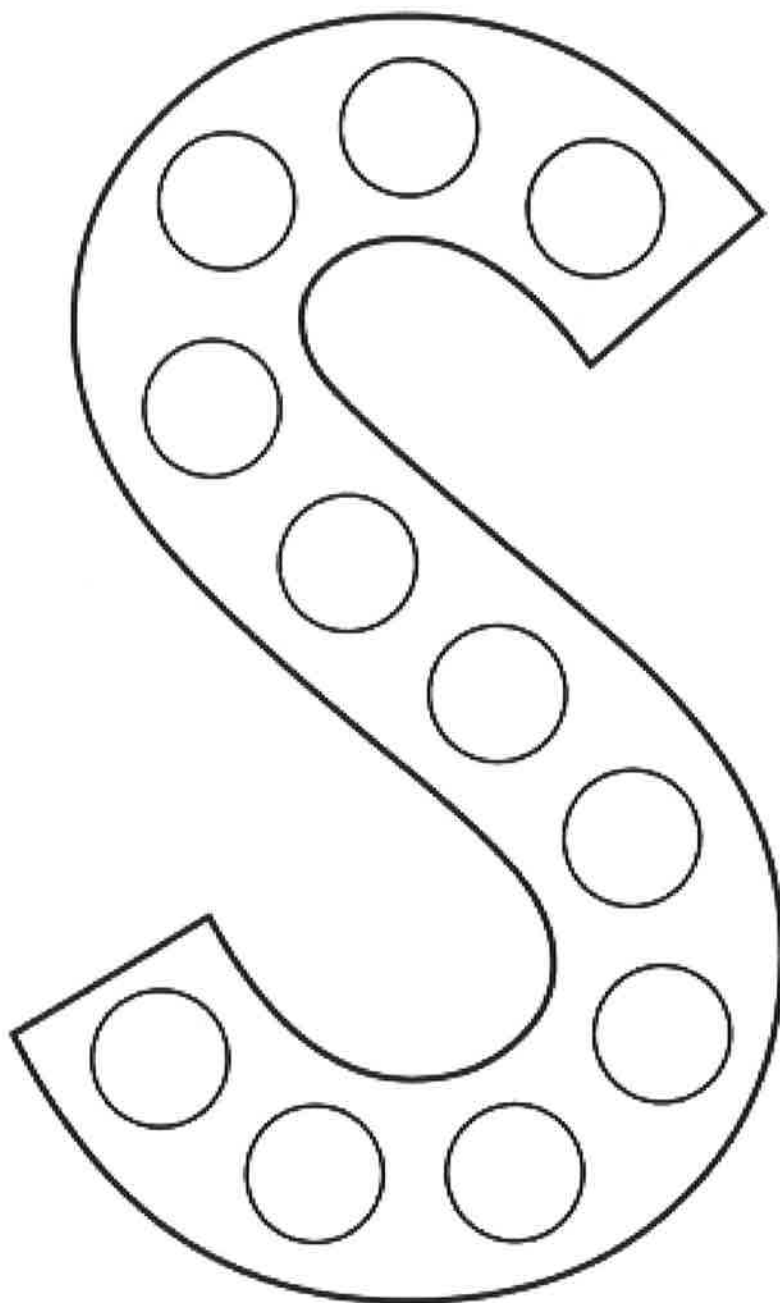
### Letter Pattern Maze

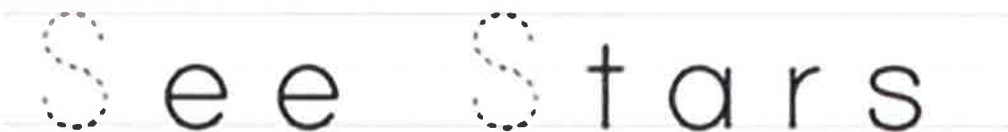
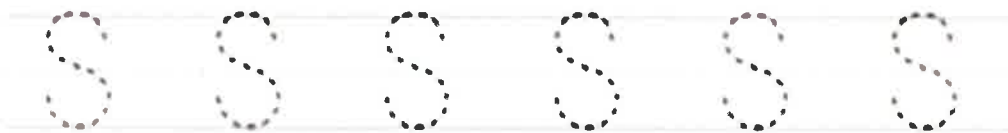


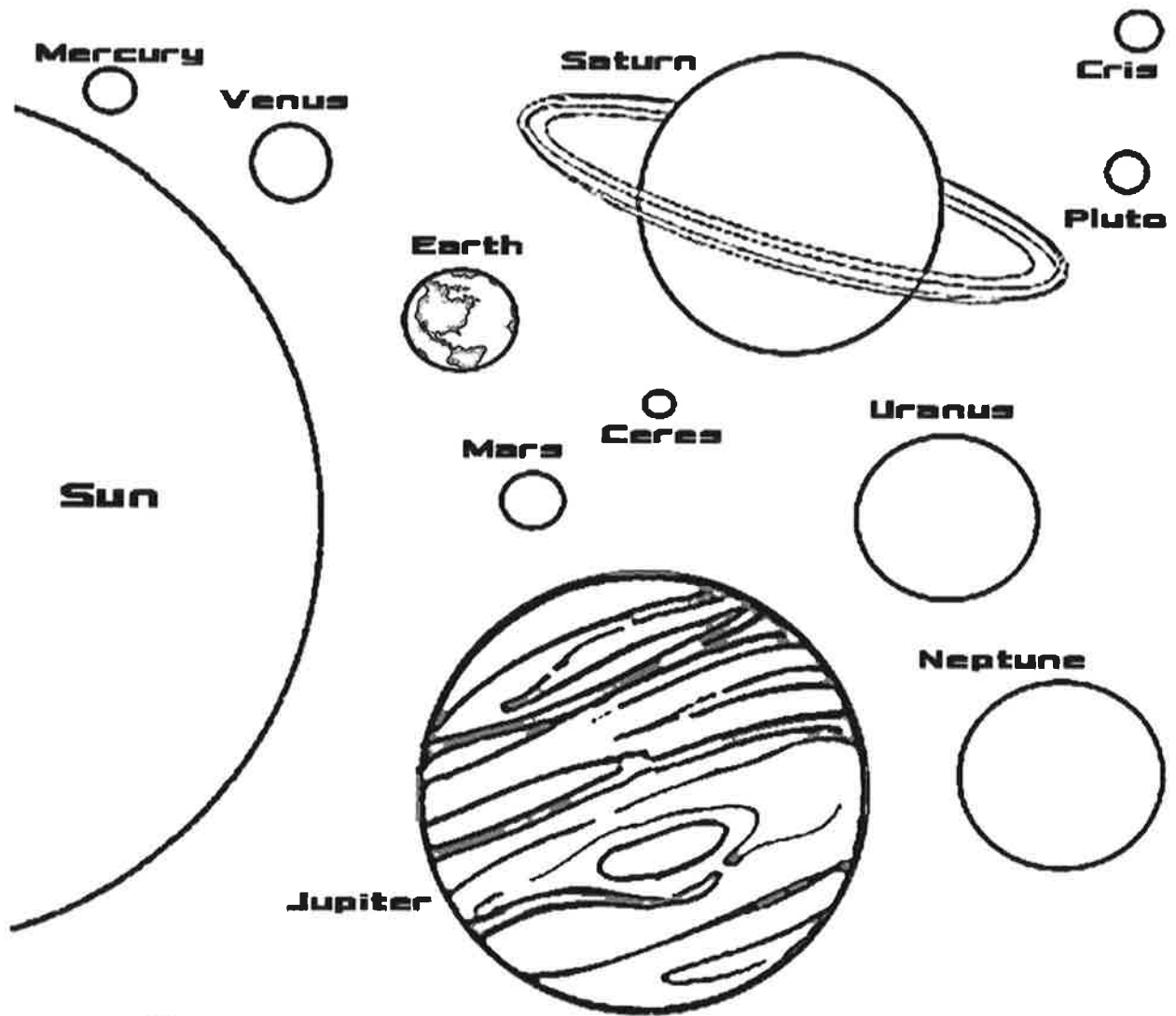

First practice tracing these wavy lines

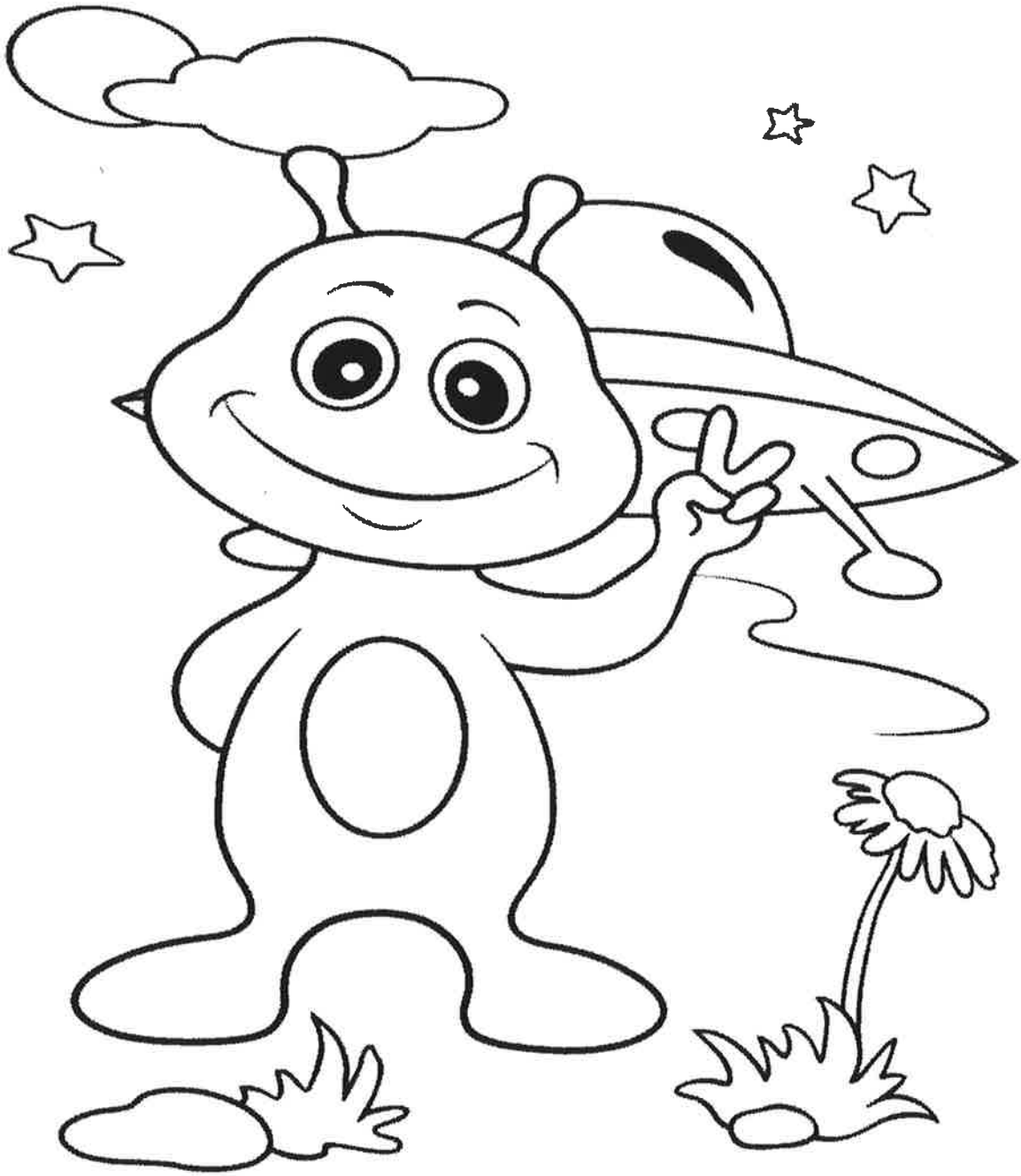

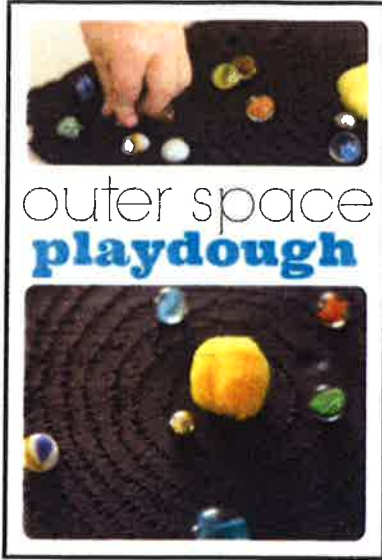


# Wee Kid's Outer Space Imagination Station

## Outer Space Playdough:



- 2 1/2 cups flour
- 1 1/4 cups salt
- 1 1/2 Tablespoons Cream of Tartar
- 2 1/2 cups water
- 5 tablespoons oil
- Black food coloring
- Glitter (you could even try glow-in-the-dark glitter)

## Space Play Dough

### Ingredients

- 1/2 cup plain flour
- 2 tbsp corn flour (cornstarch)
- 60 mls boiling water
- 2 tbsp salt
- 1 tbsp oil
- 1 tbsp hair conditioner
- black paint, or food dye
- lots of glitter



### Instructions

1. Place the flour and corn flour (cornstarch) in a medium sized bowl and mix well.
2. Make sure your water is boiling hot, then add the salt to the water and stir until it starts to dissolve.
3. Add the oil, hair conditioner and lots of black coloring to the salty water and mix well.
4. Add the water mixture into the flour and mix until it comes together to form a dough.
5. You may need to add a little more flour if your dough is too sticky, but the more you mix and knead it the softer it will become.
6. Flatten out the dough and add lots of glitter, knead the dough to mix it in.
