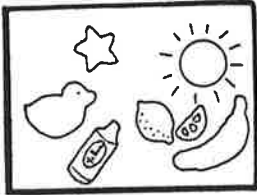
YANKEE DOODLE

ZIGZAG NECKLACES

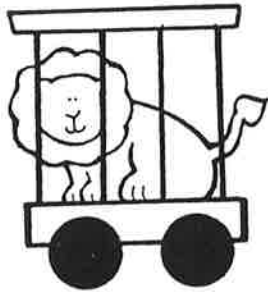
This is a great recipe that can be used for making jewelry in odd zigzag shapes. You will need: 1 cup cornstarch, 1 cup salt, 1 1/2 cups flour, and warm water. Add warm water to the dry ingredients to make a stiff dough; dust with flour to prevent the dough from becoming too sticky.

Roll the dough into long cylinders and cut them into beads. Poke a hole in the beads with a large nail. Allow the beads to dry. String the dried beads to create necklaces and bracelets.

ZOO CAGE

Who doesn't love to go to the zoo! March these cages around your room or hall. You will need: four 1" x 4" black construction paper strips, two 6" x 6" black construction paper squares, 18" x 24" manila paper, tempera paints, brushes, water containers, and white glue.

What you do: Discuss zoo animals and how they look. Select one animal and make a large painting of it on the manila paper. Allow the paint to dry (10 to 15 minutes). Glue on four cage bars. Round off corners of the two black construction paper squares to make wheels and glue the wheels at the bottom.
